The CUPE 5555 memorial bursary is designed to financially assist the children of CUPE 5555 members who are, or will be, attending college, university, or a trades program. Six (6) \$750.00 bursaries are available for this year, based on the following criteria.

- 1. The applicant must be a child, stepchild, or a child under the legal guardianship of a CUPE 5555 member in good standing or a member who passed away during their employment.
- 2. The applicant must have applied to enter or be attending a post-secondary college, university or trades program. All awards are made conditional upon the recipient being enrolled in the program for which the award is being requested along with proof of registration.
- 3. The applicant must have an established involvement/leadership in school, community, Labour/union or other social issues.
- 4. If you have previously applied and were successful in obtaining a scholarship you are not eligible to apply again.
- 5. All reference letters must be original (not copied) and signed by the originator.

*NOTE: Application must be printed legibly, or computer generated. All materials included in the application should be on single-sided 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" pages. Submissions will remain the property of CUPE 5555 and will not be returned. Email submissions must be in PDF format.
